

## **Attestation**

Notification to Members and Providers of End of Fair Hearing Flexibility

## **Purpose**

An attestation is required to confirm that MCOs have notified members about the end of the fair hearing flexibilities as outlined in MCO notice *Update to COVID-19 Accommodations for the Member State Fair Hearing Process*.

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- 1. Section I Insert the MCOs name, plan code(s) and date the form is submitted to HHSC.
- 2. Section II Review the Requirements Information
- 3. Section III Add name, signature and date

## Section II.

The MCO certifies compliance to notify members of the end of the fair hearings flexibilities, as outlined in MCO notice *Update to COVID-19 Accommodations for the Member State Fair Hearing Process,* no later than April 11, 2023. Required steps include:

- 1. Notified members that certain fair hearings flexibilities will end on May 11, 2023. MCOs have the flexibility to use multiple methods of notification (e.g., a letter, email [if there is member consent to do so]). However, HHSC expects written documentation to be provided to all members by April 11, 2023. MCOs may send one notice per household or combine with other notices. For example, if a member has three members living in the same household, one notice can be sent to the household instead of three separate notices or if a MCO is sending a notice about other COVID-19 flexibilities that are ending, they can group the notices into one combined notice.
- 2. The MCO acknowledges that they have read and understand the provisions of HHSC's request.
